In an effort to meet those needs, the board of education has scheduled a special election on April 7 to consider a bond issue that would, if approved:

1. Construct a FEMA rated classroom building that will serve as a storm shelter for our elementary students and staff. This building would house 3 classrooms and bathroom facilities.
2. Provide a retro fit metal roof over the west end of the High School facility
3. Provide a new floor in the elementary gym facility

A second ballot issue would be to

1. Provide money for buses and transportation needs.
